Agricultural Scholarship Information & Guidelines

- 1. At Least two scholarships will be awarded annually and announced during CCJLS.
- 2. Each scholarship recipient will be awarded the sum of \$1000.00 in tuition assistance during the first year of post-secondary education. This scholarship MUST be awarded within one year of high school graduation.
- 3. Each scholarship opportunity is available to any graduating senior who is currently entered as a second-year (or more) exhibitor in the current CCJLS and plans to attend a post-secondary school.
- 4. Eligibility criteria for this scholarship are:
 - A. Scholarship - the applicant must have a cumulative GPA of 3.0.
 - B. Character - the applicant must be of high moral character.
 - C. Leadership - the applicant must exhibit good leadership qualities. (4-H, FFA officer, etc.)
 - D. Agricultural Interest - must have participated as an exhibitor in at least two (2) CCJLSs, including the current year.
- 5. All monies will be paid directly to the college or institute of higher learning designated by the recipient pending enrollment verification.
- 6. The recipients of each scholarship will be selected by a person or persons designated by the Board of Directors of the Cherokee County Stock Show & Exposition, Inc.
- 7. Please type or print legibly when completing the scholarship application.
